



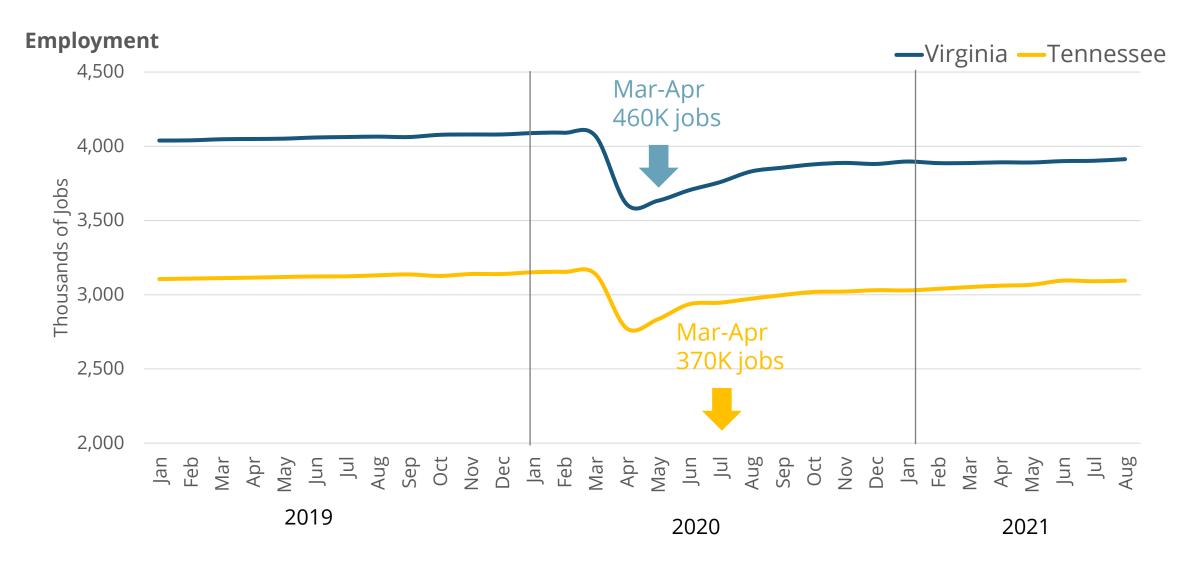

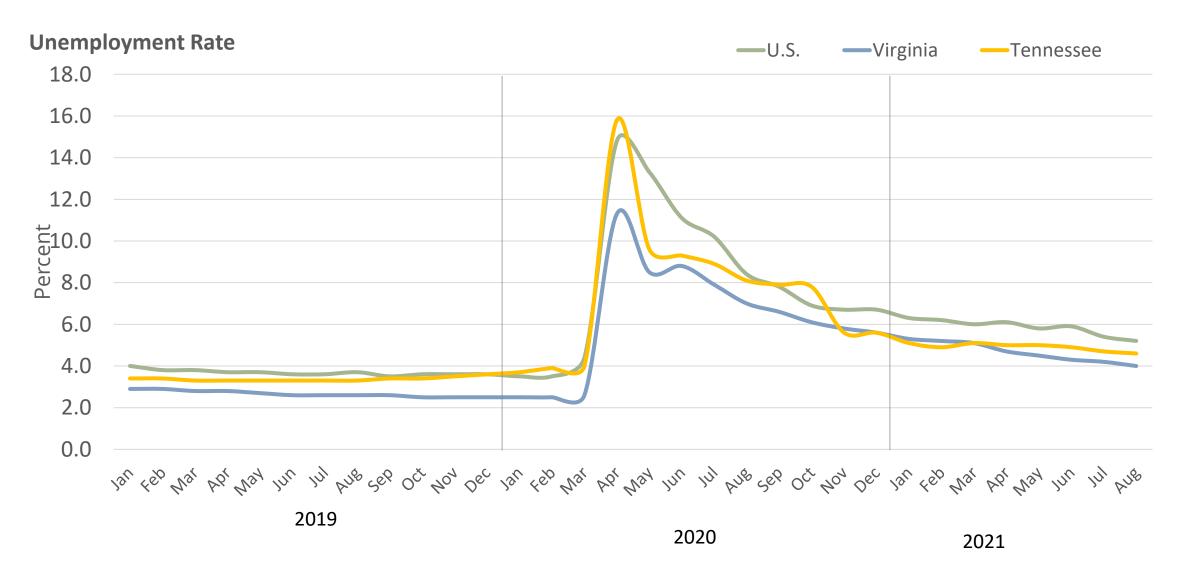

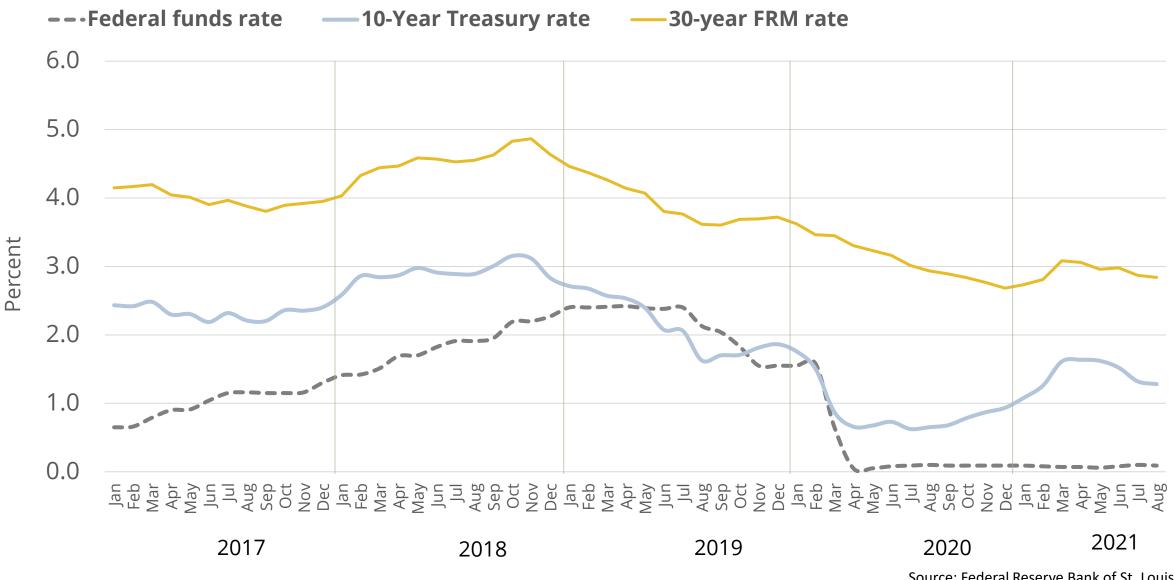
Virginia's Economy

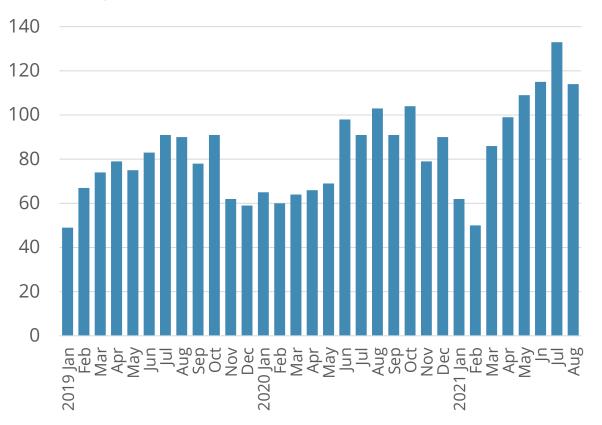

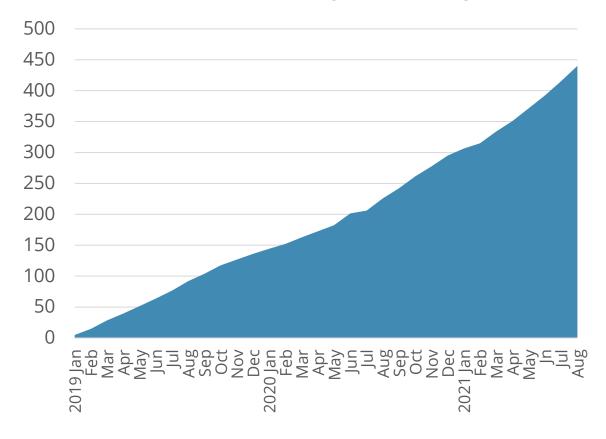


Housing Market Trends BTVAR - Virginia

Monthly Home Sales

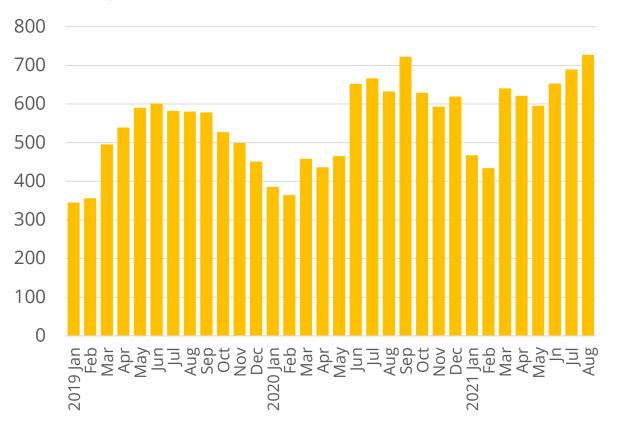


Cumulative Sold Volume (\$s millions)

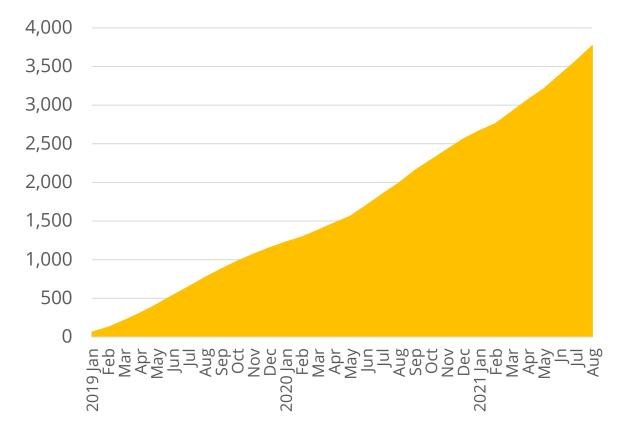

Monthly Home Sales

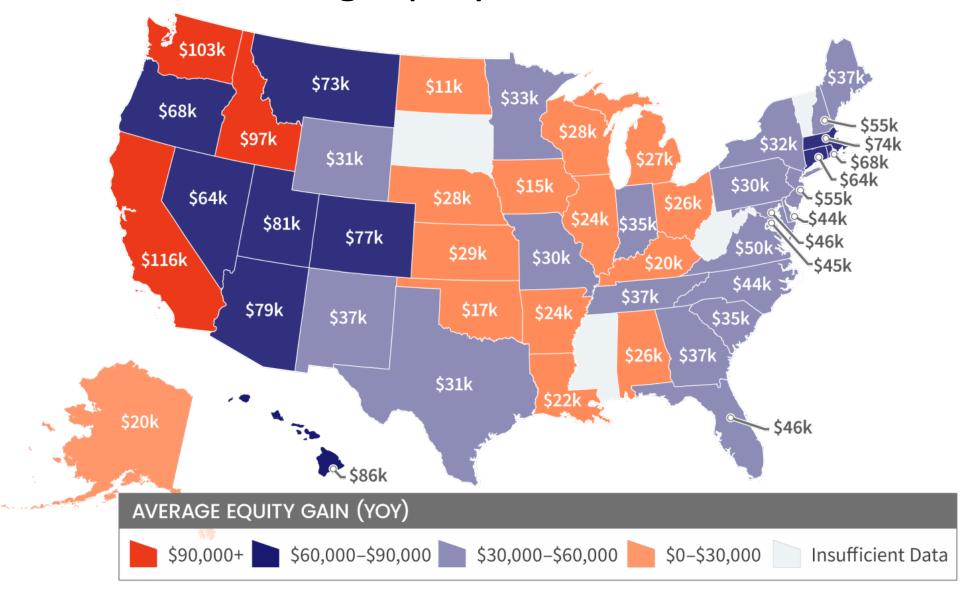


Cumulative Sold Volume (\$s millions)

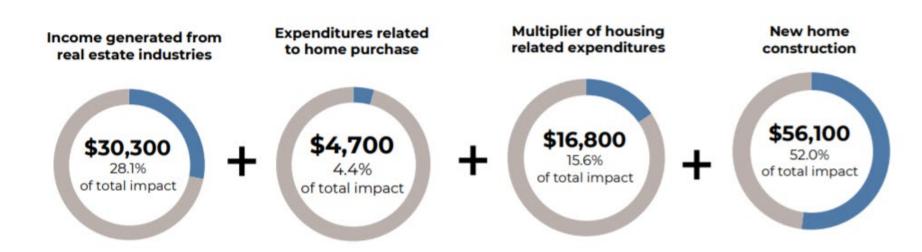

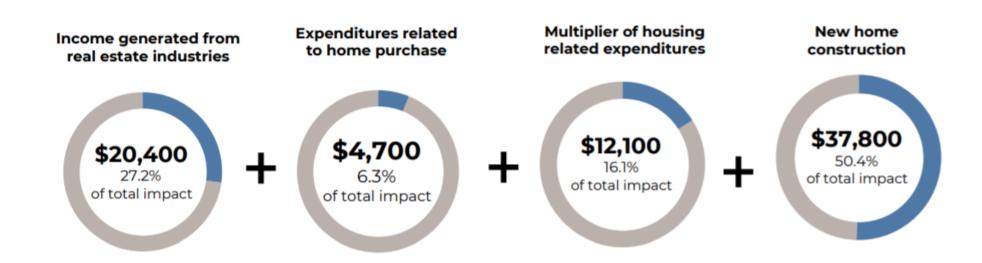

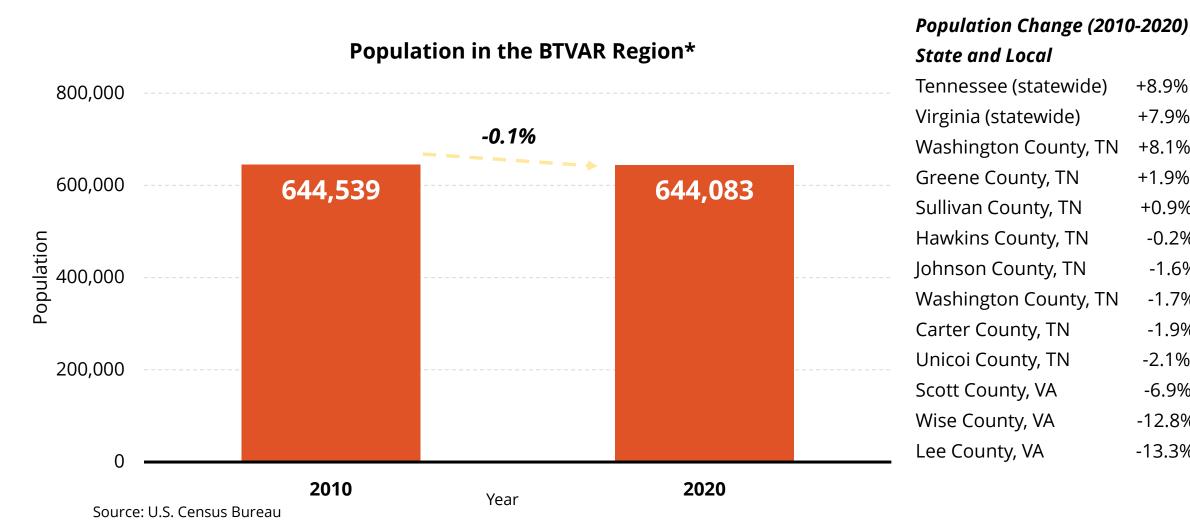

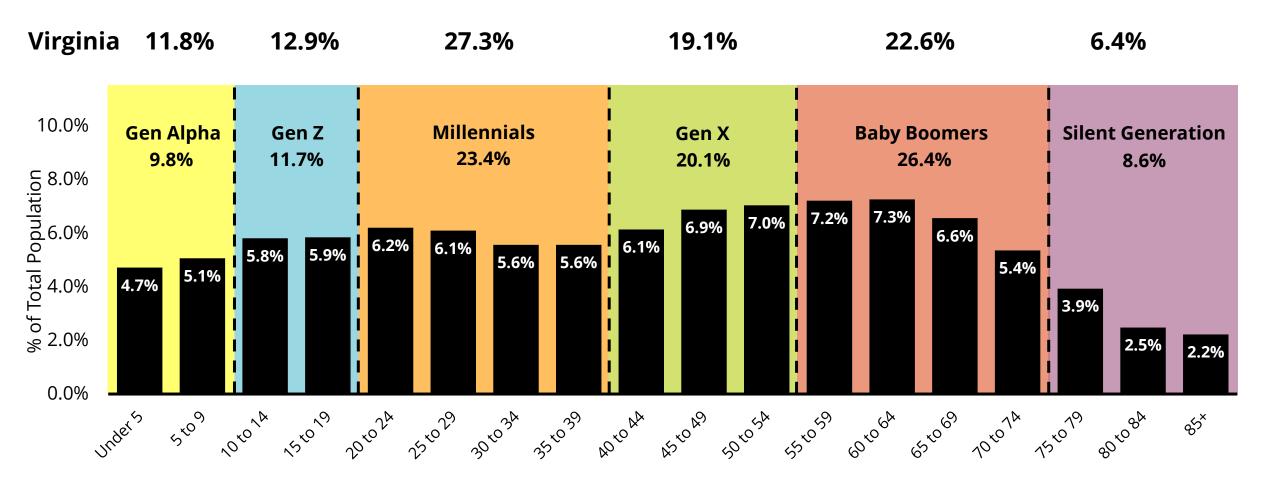
Population Change in BTVAR Region

Age Distribution in BTVAR Region*, 2019

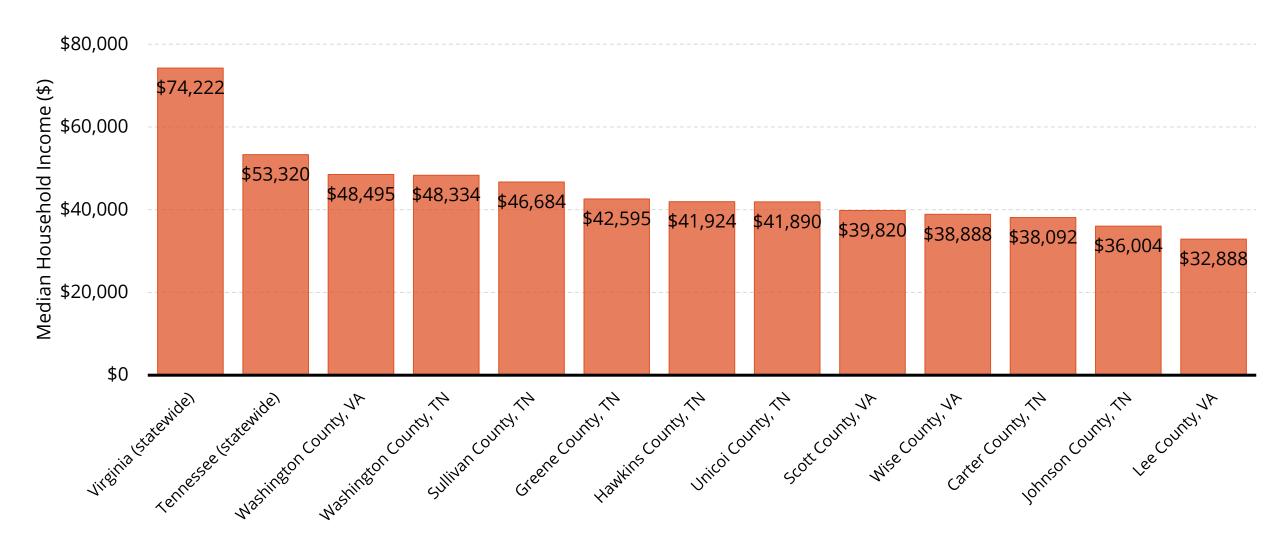
