





- Surprisingly strong housing demand fueled by high savings rates, low mortgage rates, and remote work.
- Home buyer preferences shifted to single-family homes and suburban, exurban, and small town communities.
- Prices rose at double-digit rates.















- Market cooling, heading towards a more "typical" market, with a softening of demand and a (slight) expansion of inventory.

- Continued out-migration to places with lower costs of living.





