- Provides another negotiation point in a competitive market
- Clearly states that a seller has an absolute right to retain an attorney

WHAT PARAGRAPH 10(B) IN THE VAR CONTRACT DOES NOT DO:

- Direct the seller to pay any money to the buyer
- Limit the Settlement Agent's Fee
- Provide a limit for closing costs that a seller may be willing to pay for the buyer
