

## Candidates Video Submission Criteria

All candidates for the Board of Directors are required to submit a video in accordance with the guidelines below.

### Video Guidelines

- Begin your video by stating your full name
- Please answer the following questions
  1. Why do you want to be a member of the Board of Directors?
  2. How would your real estate or other related business experience bring value to the State Association?
  3. Directors have several fiduciary duties to the association. What do those duties mean to you and how would those duties affect your behavior as a Director?
  4. What is your approach to encouraging your colleagues to support and invest in RPAC?
- Your video should be four minutes or less

### Recording Guidelines

- Good lighting
- Plain wall background (no logos, yard signs, wall of credentials, etc.)
- No introductory/closing graphics
- No company/firm logos
- No background noise (i.e., road traffic, coworker chatter, etc.)
- No added music
- HORIZONTAL videos only
- High-quality audio and video ONLY please, especially if you are using a cellphone.
- Recommended cellphone versions (iPhone 7 or later; Android S8 or later)
- If possible, have another person shoot the video with the use of a tripod
- Please review your video prior to submission

### Submission Guidelines

- Please click on this [link](#) to save your video to our Dropbox folder. You do not need to create a Dropbox account, but you WILL need to enter your name and email address.
- Videos must be uploaded within 48 hours of application submission. If the video is not submitted by the application deadline, your application will be removed from the candidate pool.
- Only video files will be accepted in the Dropbox. Photos, resumes, and/or letters of recommendation should be attached to your Board Application form.
- Your video will be posted on a Virginia REALTORS®'s web page accessible to the Delegate Body.
